The main environmental and social concerns associated with the Project are related to potential impacts to Indigenous Peoples; community health and safety impacts, particularly due to marked increase in traffic during construction and operation; potential impacts to the marine environment from dredging and driving of piles during construction; occupational health and safety; and waste management.
